Members are reminded to bring supplies including: Passport or Birth Certificate for each passenger; Photo I.D. for each passenger; Vessel Registration; Vessel Insurance (confirm approval to leave US waters for Bahamas); Health Insurance Card; Any medications you or your passengers currently require; Pens for paperwork; Life Jackets, flares and other Coast Guard required items for your vessel; Quarantine Flag (available at boating stores or check with Harbor Master); Bahamas Courtesy Flag (same as above); Tool Kit; Extra parts for your vessel such as spark plugs, fuel filters, oil filters, impellers; First Aid Kit; Bait; Fishing and Diving gear; provisions including water, Gatorade; soda; food and snacks.
